Russian road tax

The Russian government has confirmed plans to double the charges on trucks of 12 tonnes gross vehicle weight (GVW) and more under its Platon Electronic Toll Collection (ETC) scheme.

The move will see truck tolls rise from 1.53 roubles/km to 3,06 roubles/km by the middle of 2017. A draft decree covering the change shows the increase will be applied in two stages. Half in February and the rest in June.

The Russian Minister of Transport has announced the introduction of a road pricing system on Russian main roads, thereby implementing a transit fee for vehicles with a total weight above 12 tonnes. According to the Russian transport organisation ASMAP, approx. 50.000 km of Russian roads will be subject to the new tax as from November 15th 2015.

We apologise the late information on this matter. This is largely due to the lack of all the necessary details from the Russian authorities.

The resolution regarding Russian Road Tax was signed by the Russian Prime Minister on November 11th, 2015.

The fees charged for heavy vehicles on federal roads will be as follows:

From November 15th, 2015 until February 29th, 2016 charges will be RUR 1,53 per kilometre.

From March 1st, 2016 until December 31st, 2018 the tax will be raised to RUR 3,06 per kilometre
